## WHO ARE WE?

We are the professional subject association in the UK for teachers and lecturers of Business, Economics and Enterprise. We are a lively community of professionals with an unrivalled understanding of the teaching specialism.

## WHAT DO WE OFFER MEMBERS?

The EBEA offers members the opportunity to take control of their professional development and the development of the subject through engagement with their professional community. Members join and stay for the advice and resources they need for managing and teaching their subject. Key member benefits include a website, a journal each term, a monthly newsletter, an annual residential conference and other events, a teacher award, influence over government policy and support for departmental management.

## WHAT ARE THE OUTCOMES FOR STUDENTS AND SCHOOLS?

These are principally improved quality of teaching and learning and improved attainment.

## HOW ARE WE ORGANISED?

We are a charity run by teachers and independent of government and business. We have 1,800 members across the UK and grew by over 10% in the last twelve months. Most of our work is on a national basis but we run local events and have an international membership.

## WHAT IS THE COST?

Currently beginner teachers pay from £15 p.a. for the first three years of teaching, full members pay from £50 p.a. and there is an institution rate which starts at £72 p.a.. If you are paying yourself it is tax deductible but schools and colleges often consider it worthwhile supporting the cost of this outlay for the benefits accrued.

Our website offers archives of all publications and conferences including the streamed films of annual conference sessions. It has sections focused on teaching approaches and resources for specific subjects as well as generic teaching approaches. It has forums and a management section which includes a self evaluation checklist and support for the EBEA Quality Mark process.

## PUBLICATIONS

Teaching Business and Economics is typically a 36 page colour journal which includes subject updates, information related to teaching the subjects and resource reviews. It is published three times a year.

The EBEA News is an online newsletter produced each month during term time.

## DVDS OF MAIN CONFERENCES KEYNOTES

The keynotes of major conferences are filmed, uploaded to the website and sent to members as DVDs free of charge. These provide high quality and very flexible professional development as well as useful teaching materials in many cases.
